

(Adjourned meeting)

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met on this the 11th day of June 1917 with the following named officers present K. Morgan mayor presiding J. A. Behannon, W. D. Price G. W. Largent and S. W. Hawthorne, aldermen and R. P. Walker Secretary

Moved by W. D. Price and seconded by G. W. Largent that J. B. Ropers taxes on his pool table and fixtures for the year 1916 be accepted at \$ 1.60 instead of \$ 3.75 and that the said J. B. Roper be permitted to pay on the amount of property he rendered for taxes in said year 1916 instead of the amount as raised by the Board of Equalization and as said taxes were not paid before the 1st day of Feby 1917 a ten per cent penalty is figured in the above amount of settlement

Moved by S. W. Hawthorne and seconded that R. B. Shearer be paid \$ 100.00 as a balance due him on building a pump house at the pumping station and \$ 300.00 for extra work as per contract making a total of \$ 400.00 payable out of the water works operating fund of the City of Lufkin Texas

It is ordered by the Council that the secretary get an invoice book and that he keep all invoices and accounts in said invoice book

Moved and seconded that the mayor and secretary investigate all bill and claims now on file with the secretary and that the secretary issue warrants for all such claims as may be approved by the mayor

It is ordered by the council that a duplicate warrant be issued for warrant No. 1087 and that said warrant be marked duplicate

Moved and seconded that the resignation of G. W. Largent as alderman be and the same hereby accepted and that such resignation become effective from the date of this 1917.

Moved and seconded that what is known as the old city park be leased to W. S. Jones at \$400.00 per annum and the water committee appointed by H. Morgan mayor is hereby authorized and required to enter into a written contract with the said W. S. Jones leasing the said old city park to the said W. S. Jones.

Moved and seconded that the city secretary investigate the claim of B. W. Lusk as city bench officer of the city and that the secretary issue a warrant payable out of the general fund of the city for the amount of said claim the mayor may approve.

It is ordered by the city council of the city of Lufkin Texas that an election be ordered in the city limits of the city of Lufkin Texas to be held on the 14th day of July 1917 for the purpose of electing one city alderman to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of G. W. Largent and the mayor is hereby instructed to give the proper and legal notice of said election and it is further ordered that J. E. Wilson be and he is hereby appointed as presiding officer to hold said election.

There being no further business before the Council it was moved and seconded and so ordered that the Council adjourn subject to the call of the mayor or till the next regular meeting.
