Several things were discussed, but no action taken on anything, action except the passage of "Pedlers Ordinance" on first reading, which is as follows:-

"AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN SOLICITING ORDERS FOR FUTURE DELIVERY OF GOODS, WARES, MERCHANDISE, SUBSCRIPTIONS TO MAGAZINES AND NEWSPAPERS AND ORDERS FOR PHOTOGRAPHS TO BE TAKEN IN THE FUTURE WITHOUT PERMIT FROM THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, REQUIRING BOND FROM SOLICITORS ACCEPTING OR COLLECTING PAYMENT OR DEPOSIT IN ADVANCE OF FINAL DELIVERY, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAMES.

The above styled ordinance was offered for passage on first reading. Same having been read to the City Commission it was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by M. M. Jones that same pass first reading. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on said motion. "Ayes" wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke M. M. Jones. "Noes" None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.
