Mr. A. L. Garrett, State Factory Inspector, appeared before the City Council stating he had found this city was violating the state law in working its laborers more than eight hours per day. After a short talk by Mr. Garrett the Council assured him the state law would be complied with.

Carver to level and grade the streets through which he had constructed a sewer system, by making them to as good condition as they had found them, and to do so immediately.
