1941 AT 1:00 P. M.

being present, and the following absent: Commissioner W. A. Green, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Mr. Fowler, Reynolds, Sutton Gorman, and Lilly were present at the meeting.

2. The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to open bids received on Unit Number Two of the paving project. The bids received were as follows:

Reynolds & Sutton	\$ 72,314.71
C. F. Gorman & Co.	79,461.33
Roy M. Lilly	77,109.30

Action upon these bids was postponed for the regular meeting at 7:30 of this day.

3 Voucher No. 16 of Koch & Fowler to be allowed Reynolds & Sutton was approved and allowed.

4 Ben Cowart was present and requested a concession on delinquent taxes on the property owned by Mrs. J. M. Smith. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by R. E. Melvin, it was decided to reduce the valuation of the property to \$2,000.00. All Commissioners present voting "Aye".

The meeting was then adjourned to the regular meeting at 7:30 p.m.
