

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPT.
4th, 1923.

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Be it remembered that on this the 4th day of sept. 1923, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding the Hon. Sam H. Kerr, Mayor, J. W. Lewis, W. A. Behannon, and W. B. Treadwell, Commissioners. C. F. Becker, Commissioner, was absent. C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, were also present, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of former meetings read, and by move and second duly made and carried, were adopted.

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E. M. Robinson appeared in person, also by his attorney, E. J. Conn, and presented orally the question of a settlement relating to the drainage proposition adjacent and through the said E. M. Robinson's property. After considerable discussion of the matter, it was finally moved and seconded to empower C. N. Humason, City Manager, with full power to represent the city in the matter of securing a final and adequate settlement of said proposition. Motion carried unanimously.

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The question of re-treating the asphalt streets was discussed by the City Commission, and Mr. D. T. Austin, representing the firm of Haden & Austin, contractors, was present and made a proposition to re-treat said streets at the following prices, to-wit:- For applying a one course treatment at the price of 26 cents per square yard as per plans and specifications named by him, and for a two course treatment at the price of 48 cents per square yard as per specifications named by him, which said specifications are to be incorporated in a written contract for the the works if same is awarded to them. After hearing the proposition of Mr. Austin, it was moved by W. B. Treadwell and seconded by J. W. Lewis that said proposition be accepted and that the Mayor be authorized to executed on behalf of the City a contract covering the work contemplated. Said motion carried unanimously.

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An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance appropriating the sum of \$14000.00 or so much thereof as may be required to pay the expense of re-treating the streets was introduced, and after due consideration of same, it was moved by W. B. Treadwell and seconded by W. A. Behannon that said ordinance be passed and approved. The mayor put the question and requested all members of the City Commission who favored the passage of said ordinance to vote "Aye" and those who opposed to vote "No". The following members voted "Aye"- Sam H. Kerr, J. W. Lewis, W. A. Behannon and W. B. Treadwell. The following members voted "No"- None. Whereupon the mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved.

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It appearing that it is necessary to have published the delinquent tax record for the year 1922, it was moved by Commissioner J. W. Lewis and seconded by Commissioner W. A. Behannon that said delinquent tax record be published in the Lufkin Daily News ~~one time~~ according to law. said motion carried unanimously.

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
