Moved and seconded and so ordered that the Salaries or wages of Tom Russell and John Saxon as pumpmen be raised from \$50.00 to \$60.00 per month to be effective from Sept. 1st 1917

It is ordered that W. L. Jones water Commissioner place \$150.00 in the water works incidental fund to pay off some bills allowed at this meeting of the Council.

It is ordered that W. L. Jones proceed at once to lay water main on the street leading out by D. F. Parker's place in the Demman addition

It is ordered that the City Attorney draw and
Ordinance making it a fine of not less than ten
nor more than fifty Dollars for anyone except the
Firemen at the Fire Station to operate or handle
in anyway the Fire Vehicles or Motor Cars.

Moved and seconded and it is so ordered that the
Council adjourn till Friday Sept. 7th at 8 pm. 1917
