1. September bills amounting to \$4,116.01, was presented and on motion by B. F. Milligan and second by Arthur Temple, Jr, duly carried, were approved for payment.
2. A Bill for \$ 198.00 from Mr. Ashley who lives on Humenson street, claiming as damages to his car on account of a wreck with another car driven by Policeman Shaddock last March, was presented and without formal action, the City Attorney was requested to investigate as to whether the City was in any way liable.
3. Mayor Glenn also presented a water bill for Charles Samarjian with which he was dissatisfied. Without formal action the bill was turned over to the City Manager for attention.

No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
