

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
March 1st, 1938.

Be it remembered that on this the 1st day of March A. D. 1938, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

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Minutes of meetings held during the month of February, 1938 were read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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J. D. Watts appeared before the City Commission and urged a decision on the question of whether or not he shall retain possession of a certain piece of property belonging to the City and on which he has a hog ranch, or whether he will be paid for the cost of constructing a fence around the property, less accumulated rent at the rate of \$5.00 per month from about the 1st of November 1936 to date. No action was taken, but the City Manager was asked to measure the distance around the property, count the number of posts used and find out the cost of material going into the consturction of such fence and report to this City Commission at its next regular meeting.

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C. M. Anderson was present and made application for a permit to build a drive in filling station Ellis Avenue on property of Mrs. M. M. Anderson, which location is about 300 or 400 feet inside the City Limits. Application having been heard it was moved by W. D. Winston and seconded by Lewis Hicks that permission be granted provided that no property owner adjacent to the Filling Station site objected. The Mayor put the motion and it carried unanimously.

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF THE GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1938, SAME BEING THE 5th day OF APRIL, 1938, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO CITY COMMISSIONERS, ONE FROM WARD NO. 2 and ONE FROM WARD NO. 4"

was introduced for passage and approval. The said ordinance having been read to the City Commission, it was moved by J. B. Perry and Seconded by J. E. Jay that said ordinance be passed and approved. The Mayor put the

question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "Ayes"-
W. M. Glenn, W. D. Winston, Lewis Hicks, J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "Noes"-
None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance
passed and approved. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the

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There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion
duly made and carried it adjourned.
