constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The matter of transferring Taxi Cab permit formerly operated by Jim Stewart was brought up and on motion by B. F. Milligan, second by D. M. Thrash, the application of Elzie Nash was approved by all members voting Yea, except the Mayor who voted Nay.

2. The status of Highway 59 Loop through the City was discussed and without formal action, Mayor Glenn-Commissioners, Arthur Temple, D. M. Thrash and J. W. Lewis was delegated to go to Austin with District Highway Engineer V. G. Koch to confer with State Highway Engineer-Greer, in an effort to get together and get official approval, so definite plans might be made for this thoroughfare.

No further business was presented and the meeting was closed.
