2. Motion was made by R.E. Melvin, second by B.F. Milligan and carried by all members voting yea that payment of \$500.00 be accepted as settlement.
3. Applications of Brownie's Taxi and W. F. Jones for permits for Three additional taxi cabs each were presented and on motion by R.E. Melvin, second by B.F. Milligan, carried by all members voting yea, August 3rd at 7:30 PM was set as date for public hearing, as required, on the applications.
4. No one appeared to offer objection to the proposed change in the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map, hearing for which was advertised for this date.
5. Motion was made by R.E. Melvin, second by B.F. Milligan and carried by all members voting yea amending Section M of the Zoning Ordinance by adding the permissive use of "Laundry" and that the Zoning Map be amended by changing the property bounded on the North by Lufkin Avenue, on the East by Church Street, on the South by Kerr Avenue and on the West by Chestnut Street from District "B" to District "M".
6. Mr. E.J. Conn made request for permission to provide out-side surface toilets for some tenant houses he has under construction, in the event he was unable to secure materials for connecting to the sanitary sewer lines, but the permission requested was not granted.

Nothing further was offered for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
