MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,  
TEXAS, HELD July 31st, 1929.

Be it remembred that on this the 31st day of July, A.D. 1929, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit: Joe C. Denman, Mayor, C. E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, J. B. Woiton, City Engineer, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the matter of amending an ordinance regulating the installation of gas piping within the City of Lufkin, and to and perform any other business as may properly come before the meeting.

After considerable diseussion of the matter certain amendments were agreed upon, and an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 5(A), 5(H), 19, 21, 23, 25 and 27 OF AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE INSTALLATION OF GAS PIPING WITHIN THE CITY OF LUFKIN OF DATE JUNE 5TH, A.D. 1928, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES", was presented for passage and approval. C. E. Brazil made a motion that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that same pass first reading. The motion was put by the mayor, and the following vote is here entered, to-wit: "Ayes" Joe C. Denman, C. E. Brazil, C. A. Burke, R. C. Jordan and W. A. Abney. "Noes-None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading. See another page of these minutes for the ordinance.
