constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. January Bills amounting to \$3,606.68 were presented for approval and on motion of B.F.Milligan, second by R. E. Melvin, all members voting yea, were approved for payment.
2. City Zoning Board of Adjustment composed of Barney Franklin, Tom J. Melton, P. W. McCann, E. A. Gibbs and E. H. Bounds was approved on motion of R. E. Melvin, second by Jas. A. Abney, all members voting yea.
3. Question of whether or not to continue paying salary to H.V. Seaman who suffered a heart attack while on duty some time ago was discussed and on motion of Arthur Temple, Jr., second by R.E.Melvin, all members voting yea, the City Secretary was authorized to continue paying the full salary through the present month and beginning March 1st to pay him Sixty percent of his salary for not to exceed the six months following.
4. Matter of appointing S.B.Gandy as Chief of Police was discussed and on motion of B. F. Milligan, second by Jas. A. Abney that Mr. Gandy be appointed Chief of Police, Arthur Temple, Jr., B. F. Milligan and Jas. A. Abney voted yea and R. E. Melvin voted Nay. The Mayor, ~~and~~ the motion for appointment carried.
5. Motion was made by R.E.Melvin, Second by B.F.Milligan, all members voting yea, authorizing the purchase of \$10,000.00 Series "G" War Bonds, payment to be made from General Fund Account.

Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
