1. After discussion of the matter motion was made by R. E. Melvin second by B. F. Milligan and carried by all members present voting yea, providing for the suspension, for the duration of the war only, of the provision limiting the number of employees in industry to Six, on *Loss 11-12 in Block 74: 09.*

Motion was made by R. E. Melvin, second by Jas. A. Abney that Public Hearing be had on March 17th 1943 on application for changing the City Zoning Ordinance covering Block No. 14 in North Lufkin from District F. to District E.

The motion was carried by all members present voting yea.

No further business appearing for attention the meeting was recessed to March 2nd at 7:30 P.M.
