It is ordered that warrants numbers 1979 + 1980 issued to W. A. Penery and D. F. Parker for the sums of \$2.50 + \$5.25 respectively payable out of water works operating fund be cancelled and that a warrant for \$2.50 be issued to W. A. Penery and one for \$5.25 be issued to D. F. Parker both payable out of the water works incidental fund, in lieu of the said warrant #1979 + #1980.

It is ordered that warrant #296 for \$3.20 issued to Claude Green payable out of the Street + Alley improvement fund of the city of Lufkin be cancelled and that a warrant for \$3.20 be issued to R. P. Walker, the said R. P. Walker being the legal owner and holding said warrant #296.

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It is ordered that the account of W. L. Jones
as water Commissioner for \$15.00 for six days
salary as water Commissioner in the month of
Nov. 1917 be allowed. —

There being no further business it was moved
and seconded that the Council adjourn and it was so ordered.
