WHEREAS, on the 20th day of February, A. D. 1941, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, passed an ordinance providing that an election be held within said City on the first day of April, A. D. 1941, at the Municipal Office in said City for the purpose of electing a mayor and two City commissioners, said ordinance being as follows:

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING AND ORDERING OF THE GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1941, THE SAME BEING THE FIRST DAY OF APRIL, 1941, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR FROM THE CITY AT LARGE, A COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NUMBER ONE, AND A COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NUMBER THREE; PROVIDING FOR THE NECESSARY ORDERS AND NOTICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the first Tuesday in the month of April A. D. 1941, is the day set apart and designated by the Charter of the City of Lufkin, Texas, on which the General Election of the City shall be held, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin is desirous of holding such election, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS:

(1). That an election be held within the City of Lufkin, Texas, on the first Tuesday in April, A. D. 1941, the same being the first day of April, A. D. 1941, for the purpose of electing the following named officers for the ensuing two years; Mayor from the City at Large, a City Commissioner from Ward Number One and a City Commissioner from Ward Number Three.

(2). That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to call said election at the time, place and manner as provided in the Charter of said City.

(3). That said election be held at the Municipal Office in said City on said date mentioned; that notice shall be given by posting copies of NOTICE OF ELECTION in three public places within the said City, one of which shall be at the Municipal Office, the place of holding said election; that the polls shall be open to voters from eight (8:00) o'clock in the morning to six (6:00) o'clock in the evening, and all qualified voters in said City shall be entitled to vote at said election.

(4). That the following named persons be and are hereby appointed to act as managers and judges of said election:




TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS:




CONSENT TO MEETING

AN ORDINANCE RENEWING AND EXTENDING FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-FIVE YEARS FROM AND AFTER THE NINETH DAY OF JUNE, 1948 THAT CERTAIN FRANCHISE HERETOFORE, ON JUNE 9, 1923, GRANTED TO THE LUFKIN TELEPHONE EXCHANGE, A CORPORATION, FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-FIVE YEARS, THE CAPTION OF THE ORDINANCE GRANTING SAID FRANCHISE READING AS FOLLOWS: "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE LUFKIN TELEPHONE EXCHANGE, A CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, OWN AND MAINTAIN A TELEPHONE SYSTEM OR EXCHANGE, WITHIN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND WITHIN SUCH TERRITORY AS MAY BE HEREAFTER AT ANY TIME TO TIMES DURING THE LIFE OF THIS ORDINANCE BE ADDED TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY, TOGETHER WITH THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND AUTHORITY TO ERECT AND MAINTAIN IN, UPON AND UNDER SAID PUBLIC STREETS, ALLEYS AND OTHER PUBLIC GROUNDS OR PLACES, POSTS OR POLES OF WOOD OR OTHER APPLIANCES NECESSARY AND CONVENIENT FOR THE OPERATING OF THE SYSTEM OF TELEPHONE FOR TELEPHONE EXCHANGE IN SAID CITY, INCLUDING UNDERGROUND CONDUITS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF SAID TELEPHONE SYSTEM OR EXCHANGE; AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR TIME DURING WHICH SAID FRANCHISE SHALL EXIST AND THE CONSIDERATION TO BE PAID TO THE CITY OF LUFKIN BY SAID LUFKIN TELEPHONE EXCHANGE FOR SAID FRANCHISE."
