thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. February bills in the amount of \$ 3035.89 were discussed and upon motion of D. M. Thrash and seconded by E. A. Gibbs were ordered paid by unanimous vote.

2. The matter of purchasing right of way for highway 59 was brought up and after some discussion it was moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan to rescind the action taken at the regular meeting in March in regards to the purchase of Lot 12, Block 2 of the Andrews Addition. The motion carried by all members voting yea.

3. It was moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by D. M. Thrash to grant E. J. Conn a permit to install gasoline tanks for filling station purposes in block 13 of the Denman Addition at the New Nash Station and Ashley Stroud permission to change gasoline tanks at an existing station at Douglas and Ellis, with both stations to conform with all existing ordinances and regulations governing same. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

4. It was moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by E. A. Gibbs to grant D. M. Thrash permission to close the alley in Block 6 of the Fairchild Boynton Addition. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
