constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1 Motion was made by Commissioner Treadwell and seconded by Commissioner Zeagler that ordinance setting telephone rates of Lufkin Telephone Company be passed as read on second reading, and that a signed statement be furnished the City Commission by the Lufkin Telephone Company that the rates as set out in the ordinance will not be billed to subscriber until a contract is signed for the installation of the dial system. All voted "Yea."

2 Motion made by Commissioner Treadwell and seconded by Commissioner Stegall that ordinance setting telephone rates of the Lufkin Telephone Company, when dial telephone system is installed, be passed as read on second reading. All voted "Yea."

3 Motion was made by Commissioner Stegall and seconded by Commissioner Treadwell, that resolution approving the completed plans and specifications for the construction of a Municipal Building be passed as read. All voted "Yea."

The Commissioners voted to adjourn on motion of Joe Stegall and seconded by L. B. Zeagler.
