constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.


1. March bills amounting to \$2,737.25 were presented for approval and on motion of James A. Abney, second by B. F. Milligan were approved for payment.
2. The matter of providing hangar space at the Municipal Airport for privately owned planes was discussed, after which a motion was made by James A. Abney, second by E. A. Gibbs, authorizing the City Manager to make written agreement covering the type of construction and location of each hangar, and providing that title and ownership be in the City in two years after the hangar is built.
3. The rat campaign was discussed, but definite action was deferred and the City Attorney was requested to draft an Ordinance that would meet this requirement and present it at the next Commission meeting.
4. Motion was made by B. F. Milligan, second by James A. Abney, approving \$50.00 a month of County Health Nurse.
5. Motion was made by B. F. Milligan, second by James A. Abney, authorizing \$100.00 per month expense for Police Chief Gandy, during his attendance at the F.B.I. school in Washington, D. C.

No further business was brought up, so the meeting adjourned.
