

MINUTES OF called MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD July 27,  
1945 AT 3:00 P.M.

On this the 27 day of July, A. D. 1945,  
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in  
called session, in the regular meeting place in said

being present, and the following absent: Dorsie Hawkins  
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

1. The application of Lufkin Foundry and Machine Company for a change of Zone District from "A" to "K" on property purchased by the Foundry from the C. H. Harrell Estate, was presented together with written recommendation from the City Zoning Board, that the change of the Zone District be granted.
2. Motion was made by D. M. Thrash second by E. A. Gibbs and carried by unanimous vote accepting the application and recommendations and setting August 7, 1945 at 7:30 P.M. as the date of public hearing on same.
3. The matter of the Water and Sewer account of the City with the Hospital was discussed and Mayor Winston appointed E. A. Gibbs and D. M. Thrash to meet with the Hospital Board and endeavor to make an agreement with them for a mutually satisfactory basis for handling this account.
4. E. A. Gibbs offered a resolution, instructing the City Manager to take necessary steps immediately to have all delinquent taxes due the City collected and to make report each month of the progress made.

No further business was presented so the meeting adjourned.
