

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON OCTOBER 19th,
A.D. 1948, at 7:30 O'Clock P.M.

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On this the 19th day of October, A. D. 1948, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, met in a called meeting in the City Hall in said City with the following members, thereof-to-wit:

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1. The purpose of the meeting was for public hearing on Zone Changes Applications that had been properly advertised for hearing at 7:30 O'Clock and to take up any other matter that might come before the council.

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2. Mr. D. P. Wheeler was present in regard to getting a Zone Change from District "A" to District "G" on the N. 1/2 of Block 1 of the Z. C. A. Addition. Those present to protest the change were Mr. A. R. Allison, Ed. Cochran, Roy Spears and Senator John S. Redditt. After the council had heard both sides for and against the zone change. A motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by L. C. Martin that Zone Change be rejected. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "NOES" NONE.

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3. Mr. J. M. Hickman present in regard to Zone Change application on 1.45 Acres on Laurel Ave., from Zone "A" to Zone "F" which had been properly advertised, and no one appearing to protest said change. C. C. Sinclair made motion that zone change be granted and was seconded by G. W. Roland. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "NOES" NONE.

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4. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash that all bills For October due various parties and concerns be allowed and paid. All voted "AYE". "NOES" NONE.

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5. A motion was made by C. C. Sinclair and seconded by L. C. Martin that Resolution be passed Authorizing D. M. Thrash, Mayor Pro Tem, and City Secretary Cecil Massingill to execute, acknowledge and deliver to Granville Wright a quit-claim deed on a portion of the old Iron Bridge Road Right-of-way. (See another page of these minutes for a more complete description of property) Mayor Pro-Tem put motion to a vote. All Voted "AYE". "NOES". NONE.

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6. A Motion was made by C. C. Sinclair and seconded by G. W. Roland that Resolution be passed in Regard to Highway 69 South from Intersection of Chestnut and Denman Ave., Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "aye" NOES NONE.

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7. A motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that resolution be passed authorizing the extension of Frank Avenue West to the intersection of FRANKLIN Avenue. (See another page of these minutes for a more complete description) Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE" "NOES" NONE.

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8. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash that Resolution be passed for the adjustment of Valuation of City Taxes for the years 1946, 1947 and 1948 for the St. Louis S.W. Ry. Co., (Texas Division) in the amount of \$83,850.00 for each year. (See another page of these minutes for detail of resolution) Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE" "NOES" NONE.

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9, There being no further business to come before the meeting, and on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
