being present, and the following absent: E. A. Gibbs and
C. E. Brazil, constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The ordinance regulating the use of water was ammended to allow watering only between the hours of 8:00 o'clock P. M. and 11:00 o'clock P. M. of each day. Watering is permitted only on premises of houses with odd numbers on odd days of the ~~week~~^{month}; and on premises of houses with even numbers, on the even days of the ~~week~~^{month}. It was made unlawful to wash drive-ways, approaches and areas around filing stations and ice plants, as well as around all other places of business.
2. The Commission voted to allow parking of cars on the East side of South Raguet Street from Denman Avenue to Kerr Avenue.
3. Notice of final hearing on the budget was set for September 4, 1956.
4. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
