and the following absent: Mayor W. M. Glenn; when the following business was had:

1. Mayor pro tem G. E. Barington, acting in the absence of Mayor W. M. Glenn, stated that this meeting was an adjourned session of the public hearing on the paving assessments which was held on October 22, 1940 at 2:00 p. m. and that the Council was ready to hear other objections.

2. Sam H. Townsend, Sr. appeared in objection to the paving program and objected for the reason that he did not think Lufkin needed any more paving and for the further reason that he was unable to pay for paving of his property on Humason Street. He further stated that it was his opinion that the paving would not benefit his property as much as the cost would be. He stated that he would be willing to sell any of his lots for the taxes and \$150.00.

3. There being no other objectors appearing, the ordinance closing the hearing and levying the assessments was introduced and passed on first reading. The proceedings upon the passage of this ordinance on first reading will be found immediately following these minutes.

4. An ordinance amending and changing the plans for Townsend Alley was introduced and passed upon first reading. The proceedings upon the passage of this ordinance will be found immediately following these minutes.

5. An ordinance amending and changing the plans and contract for allowing the rock crusher to be set up in town instead of at the rock quarry was introduced and passed. The proceedings

on the passage of this ordinance will be found immediately following these minutes.

6. The meeting was adjourned until Tuesday, November 5, 1940 at the regular monthly meeting of the Council for passage of the above ordinances on second reading.
