MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS.  
HELD SEPTEMBER 1st, 1936.

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Be it remembered that on this the 1st day of September, A.D. 1936,  
there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of  
the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the  
following officers of the city present and presiding:

Kenneth Hoskins,	Mayor,
W. O. Greene,	Coms. Ward No. 1,
Lewis Hicks,	Coms. Ward No. 2,

Curtis W. Fenley,	City Attorney, and

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of meetings held during the month of August, 1936, were  
read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND  
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD WITHIN  
WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN ON THE  
THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF AUGUST, 1936, FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COMMISSIONER FROM  
WARD NO. 3, IN AND FOR SAID CITY"

was introduced for passage and approval. W. O. Greene made a motion that  
said ordinance be ~~read~~ to the City Commission and that it be passed and ap-  
proved. Lewis Hicks seconded said motion. The Mayor put the question and  
the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins,  
W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks and J. E. Jay. "NOES" - None. Whereupon the  
Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved.

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J. D. Martin, lessee of the Jones Lake Property was present and  
stated that inasmuch as his lease would shortly expire and that he would  
like to have it renewed, desired that some action be taken regarding  
the matter. The said J. D. Martin proposed to pay annual rental of  
\$125.00 cash and to keep up the property as heretofore provided in previous  
lease contracts. After discussing the matter it was moved by Lewis Hicks  
and seconded by J. E. Jay that the present lease be extended for one year  
from its expiration date, on the same terms and conditions as heretofore  
provided, except that he is to pay \$125.00, cash rent instead of \$75.00  
as heretofore provided. The motion carried unanimously.

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City Tax Collector, T. L. Dunn, presented the completed Tax Rolls  
for the year 1936, of the City of Lufkin, and asked that they be examined

and approved. They were examined and on motion made by W. O. Greene, seconded by J. B. Perry, they were approved, and such approval was indicated by each member of the City Commission signing his name to said rolls.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried ~~it~~ adjourned.
