MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD APRIL 10th, A.D.1928.

Be it remembered that on this the 10th day of April, A.D. 1928,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City:
Present and presiding the following officers of the City: J. W. Haw-
kins, Mayor, Joe C Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker,
Commissioner of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3,
E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager,
W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the
following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting as announced by the Mayor was to de-
clare the result of an election held on the 3rd day of April, A. D.
1928, for the purpose of electing a city commissioner from Ward No.
2 and a city commissioner from Ward No. 4, and such other business as
may properly come before the body.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF
LUFKIN ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, A.D. 1928, SAME BEING THE 3rd
DAY OF APRIL, 1928, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELECTING A CITY COMMISSIONER
FROM WARD NO. TWO AND A CITY COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO. FOURTH, was
presented for passage and approval. Same having been read to the City
Commission, it was moved by J. C. Denman and seconded by M. C. Spivey,
that said ordinance be passed and approved. The mayor put the question
and requested those members who favored said motion and the passage and
approval of said ordinance to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No".
The following members voted "Aye"- J.W.Hawkins, Joe C.Denman, A.M. Wal-
ker, M.C.Spivey and E.W.Leach. The following members voted "No"- None.
The Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance finally passed
and approved.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF FIRE
MARSHAL, PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR ITS MAINTENANCE,
AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS", was presented for passage
and approval as an emergency measure. M. C. Spivey made a motion which

was seconded by Joe C. Denman, that said ordinance be passed as an emergency measure; that the rule demanding that ordinances be read on two separate days be suspended and that said ordinance be placed on its first and final reading and take effect according to the tenor thereof. The Mayor put the question and requested those members of the City Commission who favored said motion and the passage and approval of said ordinance to vote "Yes" and those opposed to vote "No". The following members voted "Yes"- J.W.Hawkins, Joe C. Denman, A. A. Burke, M.C. Spivey, and Willie A. Abney. The following members voted "No"- None.- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance finally passed and approved.-
