The following proceedings were had, to-wit:--

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The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was decide definitely whether or not the City would buy a Street Maintainer, and if so to consider bids for the purchase of one.

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The matter of whether or not the city should buy a street maintainer was duly discussed and the City Manager having recommened the purchase of such machine, it was moved by CyA Burke and seconded by W.A. Abney that such machine be bought. The motion carried unanimously.

Adams & Co be rejected and the choice of machines limited to those offered by the Austin Brodge Co and the R. B. Everett Co; choice to be made after inspection of the respective products by the me^mbers of the City Commission.

The mayor put the question and the following is the vote taken by the City Commission. "Ayes"- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke and W. A. Abney. "Noes"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
