The matter of awarding contract for Liquid Chlorine Requirements for twelve months was discussed, and it appearing that bids had been submitted by the following: Thompson-Hayward Chemical Co. through Burke Drug Store, Gulf Coast Chemical Company, through E. W. Leach Grain Co, The Mathieson Alkali, Works, through Lufkin Foundry & Machine Co. and Monsonta Chemical Company, through Butler Drug Store. All bids being identical as to price, etc. on recommendation of the City Manager, the contract was awarded to Monsonta Chemical Co, through Butler Drug Store at a net price of $11\frac{1}{2}$ % per pound.

Accounts and bills due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment and it appearing that such of said bills and accounts as had been properly approved for payment by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried were allowed.
