being present, and the following absent: Granville Wright, Commissioner, Ward No. 1, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

- 1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
- 2. The minutes of the regular meeting held on August 17, were read and approved.
- 3. Zone changes were finally passed upon the applications of Mrs. Kornagey, Merlè O. Smith, and D. B. Nerren, as applied for by each applicant.
- 4. Mr. J. H. Nowlin headed a delegation requesting that the drainage on Third Street on the East side of Pinedell Manor be improved. After discussing the matter it was agreed that Mr. Sherrill would look into the situation and make such necessary corrections as could be made.
- 5. Mr. Falcor Perry came before the Commission and discussed the details of an addition he proposed to open on South Raguet to Cimmarron Street. Mr. Perry stated that he had an agreement with Mr. Kit Thompson to buy a 50 ft. lot whereby he could connect the two streets and he was advised to work out the details of his plat with Mr. Sherrill, the City Manager, and submit it according to our plat and subdivision ordinances for approval.
- 6. The Commission voted to advertise the zone change as applied for by Mrs. Virgie Schuller on Lots 4 and 5 of Block 1, of the Schuller Addition for zone change from "A" District to "B" District.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
