agree to pay to Lane & Bowers the sum of
\$3500⁰⁰ for the well now being drilled, if
finished at a depth of 2000 feet or less,
provided it has a pumping capacity of
not less than 300,000 gallons of water per
day of 24 hours, provided that they use
due diligence in completing same.
It is understood that Lane & Bowers
be allowed to reduce the size of
casing from time to time as they may
see proper. Said Lane & Bowers to guarantee
said quantity of 300,000 gallons per day of
24 hours for a period of One Year.
