MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD OCT.  
4th, 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 4th day of October A.D. 1932,  
there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission in  
and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City,  
with the following officers of the City present and presiding to-wit:-

Wm. A. Foster,	Mayor,

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of all meetings held during the month of September, 1932,  
were read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

-----oOo-----

A Committee headed by E. L. Corson, secretary of the Y.M.C.A.  
appeared before the City Commission and requested that if it would  
not be violating any rule of the City and at the same time if The  
local School authorities had no objection, permission would like to  
be obtained to build an out-door gymnasium in the present City Park  
grounds, located near the Kurth Ward School. The matter was thorough-  
ly discussed, after which it was suggested that the matter be brought  
before the School Board and then again report to this City Commission  
their attitude regarding same, after which the City would take action  
on the matter.

The City Manager brought before the City Commission the matter of  
constructing a 6 inch lateral sewer line parallel to the present 15inch  
sewer line on the east side of the Highway (No. 35) on the south side  
of the City limits for the purpose of providing sewer service to cus-  
tomers adjacent thereto without being bothered with back water from  
the present 15 inch sewer. The matter of installing a trap or gate  
valve at the sewer connections of A.E. Grager and Edw. Bie Lowery, (both  
being connected at the same point) as an alternate measure to eliminate  
back water from their premises, they being the only ones seriously  
affected at this time. Both measures were duly considered, after which  
it was moved by M.M. Jones and seconded by C.A. Burke that the trap or  
gate valve be installed at this time, and that the construction of the

six inch sewer be postponed for the time being. The motion carried unan-  
imously and the City Manager instructed to have constructed a proper gate  
valve or trap and install same at the point aforesaid.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND REGULATING MAXIMUM  
RATE AND COMPENSATION TO BE CHARGED BY ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION  
FURNISHING NATURAL GAS TO CONSUMERS IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN; MAKING IT  
UNLAWFUL FOR SUCH PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO CHARGE A HIGHER RATE  
OF COMPENSATION OR TO REFUSE TO FURNISH GAS UNLESS A HIGHER RATE OF COM-  
PENSATION IS PAID OR PROMISED THAN IS PROVIDED FOR HEREIN, AND FIXING A  
PENALTY FOR EACH VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE", was presented for passage

and approval on second and final reading. C. A. Burke made a motion that  
said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that same be  
passed and approved on such second and final reading. The motion was  
seconded by M. M. Jones. The Mayor put the question, requesting all mem-  
bers who favored the ~~passage~~ motion and the passage and approval on second  
and final reading of the ordinance aforesaid to vote "Aye" and those op-  
posed to vote "No"- The following is the recorded vote on the motion:  
"Ayes"- Wm A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C.A.Burke, M.M.Jones and W.A.Abney.  
"Noes"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the  
ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading. (See another  
page of these minutes for a record of said ordinance).

All accounts and bills due by the city to various parties firms,  
and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that such  
of said bills as had been properly approved by the City Manager should  
be paid, on motion duly made and carried same were allowed.

motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
