

MINUTES OF CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
MARCH 21st, 1936.

Be it remembered that on this the 21st day of March, A.D. 1936,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was stated to be to consider the
passage of a resolution pertaining to the Approval of the Lufkin Muni-
cipal Airport and requesting WPA to place said Airport Project in a pre-
ferred class over all other projects, and to do and perform any other
business that might properly come before the meeting.

A resolution providing: That the Works Progress Administration be
requested to approve the Airport Project immediately so that work may be
gotten under way the project completed at the earliest possible date,
and further that the Works Progress Administration be advised that the
City Commission prefers placing the Airport Project in the preferred
position over any existing projects that may be approved for the City
of Lufkin or Angelina County, utilizing the labor in the City of
Lufkin, was introduced for passage and approval, and it was moved by
Commissioner W. O. Greene and seconded by W.A. Abney that said resolution
be passed and approved. The motion was put by the Mayor and the follow-
ing is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O.
Greene, Lewis Hicks and W.A. Abney. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor de-
clared the motion carried and the resolution passed and approved.
