## MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS. June 3rd, 1924.

Be it remembered that on this the 3rd day of June, A. D. 1924, there came on and was held a regular meeting of the Honorable City Cormission of the City of Lufkin, in the City Hall of said City, there being present and presiding the following officers: Sam H. Kerr, Mayor, C. F. Becker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, Kenneth Hoskins, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of former meeting read, and by move and second duly made and carried were adopted.

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The budget for the year beginning April 1st, 1924 and ending March 31st, 1925 which was prepared by City Manager C. N. Humason, was submitted, after which it was ordered that same be published as provided by the Charter of said City, and that April 20th, 1924 at \$:30 o'clock P.M. be and is hereby designated as the date at which time a public may be had hearing as to whether said Charter should be adopted or not.

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The proposal of the C. & I. Engineering Company of Lufkin, Texas, to make a special survey and compile data for equalization of property was presented and read to the City Commission, and after due consideration of same A. M. Walker made a motion to accept same which was seconded by Kenneth Hoskins. The motion carried unanimously.

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AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO PAY THE PURCHASE PRICE BOR LOT 5 BLOCK 1 North Reilroad Reservation Subdivision of the City of Lufkin, Texas.

Whereas, it appearing that Lot 5 Block 1 of the North Railroad Reservation is now and has been for a number of years used for street purposes and that the title to said lot is in the Flournoy Heirs, and it further appearing that said Flournoy Heirs have made a proposition to the City to sell said lot at a price of \$333.35, Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUPKIN:

That the sum of Three Hundred thirty three & 35/100 (\$353.35)

Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the City of Lufkin for the payment of the purcahse price of Lot 5 block 1 of the North R.R. Reservation Subdivision of the City of Lufkin. Texas.
