

NOTICE OF CALL MEETING.

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN TEXAS AND

of canvassing the returns and declaring the results of an election

of submitting to the qualified voters of the said City the question
"Shall a Commission Be Chosen to Frame a New Charter", and electing
fifteen members of such commission, and to do and perform such other
things and matters as may properly come before the body.


Be it further ordained by the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas, that it be, and it is hereby declared, that W. R. McMullen, G. R. Thompson, Kester Denman, G. A. Kelley, S. M. Morris, Dr. W. W. Dunn, W. C. Binoin, B. A. Singleton, Nat Wright, Frank Dunlap, Jake Markus, Lee Zeagler, S. H. Townsend, R. J. Behannon and W.C. Trout duly elected as the commission to frame a new charter for the city of Lufkin, Texas in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 17, Title 22, Articles 1096a to 1096i, both inclusive, of Vernon's Sayles' Texas Civil Statutes 1914, and the said commission is hereby authorized to frame a new charter for the City of Lufkin, Texas, in accordance with provision of Chapter 17, Title 22, Articles 1096a to 1096i of Vernon's Sayles' Texas Civil Statutes 1914; that said commission shall report to this Council as soon as their labors are concluded.

That this ordinance take effect and be in force from and after its final passage and approval by the Mayor.
