ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
2. The Minutes of the Regular Meeting of December 7, were read and approved.
3. Bids for one police car were opened for consideration. Angelina Chevrolet Company's bid of \$1485.00 for Model 210 Chevrolet was low bidder. It was agreed to accept this bid with additional heavy duty kit of \$27.50.  
After some discussion of buying another car for the Police Department, the Angelina Chevrolet Company & Gibbs Motor Company were asked to look at another car that was to be traded. They each submitted bids of \$1512.50. It was agreed to purchase from Gibbs Motor Company a 4-door Savoy Plymouth.
4. The alley extending East and West through Block Number Two of the Kerr Addition was closed and vacated with utility reservations retained by the City.
5. Monthly bills were approved for payment.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
