constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Minutes of December meetings were read and regularly approved.
2. Letters from Mrs. McMullen expressing appreciation to the Commissioners for increasing the City's contribution to the Kurth Memorial Library from \$150.00 to \$200.00 per month, and also a letter from the Layne-Texas Company, expressing favorable comment on analysis of water from the new well, were read.
3. Mr. Scott Sayers, representing Texas Foundries Inc., made request for concrete culvert under street through the Foundry Addition.
4. After discussion, motion was made by Arthur Temple, Jr., second by B. F. Milligan, and carried without dissenting vote that installation of concrete culvert be authorized.
