MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
SEPTEMBER 15th, A.D. 1939.

Be it remembered that on this 15th day of September A.D. 1939, there was begun and holden a Special Meeting of the City Commission of the City Of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the city present and presiding, to-wit:

The following proceedings were had to-wit:

1. The council discussed the Pit Toilet Situation with Mr. Russell, and it was decided that all pit Toilets that were found in an Insanitary Condition on any person's property, that he or his agent would be given notice to connect to the Sanitary Sewer System of the City of Lufkin, Texas. A Motion was made by W. D. Winston and seconded by R. C. Arnett that All Pit Toilets in An Insanitary Condition--Owners be notified to Connect ^{By Mr. Russell,} same to Sanitary System of City of Lufkin, Texas. The Mayor put the question to a vote. All voted "AYE"--"NOES" None.

2. The Position of City Judge was discussed by city Council and it was decided to wait until 1st meeting in October to select a man for this position.

3. A motion was made by W. D. Winston, Jr., and seconded by Lewis Hicks, that City Tax Rolls for the year 1939 be approved. Carried Unanimously.
