

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JUNE 23, 1915.THE STATE OF TEXAS,
THE CITY OF LUFKIN.

Be it remembered that on this 23rd day of June, A. D. 1915, there came on and was held a SPECIAL CALLED SESSION of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas, in the Council Chamber, pursuant to due notice given, and service thereof duly accepted, and was called to order at 7:30 o'clock P. M., by the Hon. Mayor, with the following Aldermen and other officers present:

City Engineer, P. A. McCarthy, who was also ~~also~~ ~~been~~ previously appointed to act a City Secretary Protempor by Mayor Mantooth, in the absence of City Secretary H. B. Satterfield, who was engaged in the most important business of life.

Gentlemen:

You, and each of you, are hereby notified, that a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, is hereby called to meet at the Council Chamber in the City Fire Station, at 7:30 o'clock, this Tuesday evening, June 23, 1915, for the ~~purpose~~ purpose of considering, and if favorable, the adoption of an ordinance to pave part of Dozier Avenue, between the Easterly ~~line~~

property line of First Street and the Easterly property line of Second Street with Bitulithic pavement.

Also, that part of Second Street between the Northly property line of Lufkin Avenue, and the Southerly property line of Dozier Avenue with Bitulithic pavement.

Also, that part of Lufkin Avenue, between the Easterly property line of Second Street and the Easterly property line of Third Street, or some intermediate point, with Bitulithic pavement.

Also, Ellis Avenue, across the right of way of the Houston East & West Texas Railway Company, between ~~the~~ Angeline Avenue and the Westerly right of way line of said Houston East & West Texas Railway Company, with Bitulithic pavement.

Also, to adopt specifications for said pavement; to order the Texas Bitulithic Company to execute the work of paving as additional or extension work under the provisions of the contract entered into between the City of Lufkin, and said Texas Bitulithic Company.

The levy of assessments against the abutting property ~~owners~~ and ~~maxx~~ property owners for the payment of one-third (1/3) of the pavement abutting on each side of the several lots and blocks along Dozier Avenue, Second Street, and Lufkin Avenue, and for the payment of the curbs on each side of said blocks; to levy an assessment against the Houston East & West Texas Railway Company for the payment of the pavement and curbs crossing its right of way at Ellis Avenue as aforesaid.

To order notices to be given to the several property owners to appear and show cause at a date to be fixed, and to file objections, if any they have, to the levying of said assessments.

To amend an ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE IMPROVEMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, ON BOTH SIDES OF FIRST STREET, BETWEEN GROSEBECK AVENUE AND SHEPHERD AVENUE; ON BOTH SIDES OF LUFKIN AVENUE, BETWEEN FIREMAN'S PARK AND SECOND STREET; ON BOTH SIDES OF DOZIER AVENUE, BETWEEN ANGELINA AVENUE AND FIRST STREET; ON THE NORTH, EAST AND SOUTH SIDES OF FIREMAN'S PARK; ON BOTH SIDES OF COTTON STREET; AND ON THE EAST SIDE OF ANGELINA AVENUE, EXCEPT THAT PORTION ALONG AND

FRONTING THE WEST SIDE OF FIREMAN'S PARK, passed and approved on the 1st day of June, A.D. 1915, for the extension of the proposed sidewalks within the paving district as proposed to be enlarged, and for the correction of said ordinance, and,

Also, to authorize and empower the Mayor and City Secretary to negotiate loans for the payment of the City's share of the proposed new pavement and to execute the note, warrant, or other obligations of the City for the payment of said loans; to create special funds out of which said obligations shall be paid, and transact such other business as may legally come before the Council.

Also to adopt an ordinance closing streets or parts of streets during improvements or other work thereon; to prevent the use of said streets or parts of streets so closed, and providing penalties for using streets or parts of streets while closed.
