MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,  
HELD ON SEPTEMBER 8th, 1931.

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Be it remembered that on this the 8th day of September, A.D. 1931,  
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the  
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the fol-  
lowing officers of the city present and presiding, to-wit:-

R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent on account of  
sickness.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to complete  
unfininhd business carried over from a previous meeting and do and perform  
any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

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Mr. N. D. Shands, representative of The Texas Power & Light Company  
appeared before the City Commission and presented a new contract to be  
executed by the City for a supply of power or energy in the operation of  
pumps at the water plant and for street lighting purposes. Action on the  
matter was postponed until September 15th at which time another meeting  
would be held by the City Commission.

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It appearing that it would be necessary to institute suits for col-  
lection of delinquent City Taxes and that before suit could be filed it  
would be necessary to secure title sheets on the property to be sued upon,  
and City Attorney R.C. Musslwhite having secured bids from the two abstract  
Companies for the furnishing of such title sheets, same were opened and  
read as follows:-

Homer Garrison Abstract Co- \$1.00 per track  
Angelina County Abstract Co- \$350.00 for approximately  
700 tracks.

Said bids having been duly considered by the City Commission,  
it was moved by W.A. Abney and seconded by W.O. Greene that the bid of  
Angelina County Abstract Company be accepted. The motion carried.

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City Secretary T. L. Dunn, who is also City Tax Collector for the  
City of Lufkin presented for examination and approval the 1931 City Tax  
Rolls. After examining same it was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by  
W. O. Greene that same be approved. The motion carried unanimously.

*Sept 20*

Mrs. Ailee et als filed a claim in the amount of \$4,000.00 for damages they claim to have sustained by reason of the City Sewer disposal plant being located near certain property owned by them. The matter was thoroughly discussed, and was referred to City Manager A.F. Daniel and City Attorney R.C. Musslewhite for investigation and recommendation.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
