"A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, CALLING AN ELECTION ON THE PROPOSITION OF THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING CERTAIN REPAIRS, EXTENSIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF SAID CITY; AND ON THE PROPOSITION OF THE ISSUANCE OF \$50,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING CERTAIN REPAIRS, EXTENSIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SEWER SYSTEM OF SAID CITY, AND PLEDGING THE REVENUES OF THE WATERWORKS AND SEWER SYSTEM TO THE PAYMENT THEREOF"


On motion duly made and carried which is fully set out in the body of the Resolution which is of record at another page of these minutes, the resolution was passed and approved on first reading.
