A petition of Robert Harrison et al asking that a water line be
laid on Adams street in the Adams Addition to the City of Lufkin, was
duly considered, after which by motion duly made and carried the City
Manager was given authority to lay such water line.

The application of Tom Mantooth, former policeman, for an addi-
tional allowance of \$50.00 as salary for two weeks in advance of the
date he was discharged as such policeman was duly considered, after which
R. C. Jordan made a motion which was seconded by C.E. Brazil that same
be not allowed. The motion carried unanimously.
