Minutes of all former meetings read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

The application of Robert Harrison et al asking that a water line be laid on Adams street in the Adams Addition to the City of Lufkin, was duly considered, after which by motion duly made and carried the City Manager was given authority to lay such water line.

The application of Tom Mantooth, former policeman, for an additional \$50.00 to be paid him as salary for two weeks in advance of the date he was discharged as such policeman was duly considered, after which R. C. Jordan made a motion which was seconded by C.E. Brazil that same be not allowed. The motion carried unanimously.

All bills and accounts due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appeared that such of said bills as had been properly audited and approved for payment by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried, same were allowed.
