1. Meeting was opened with prayer by Rev. Dan March, Minister, First Christian Church.

2. CANVASS OF ELECTION RESULTS

Mayor Bronaugh stated that the City Commission had met to canvass the results of the Regular City Election held Saturday, May 6, 1989, for Wards 1 and 3.

The returns indicating results of the Regular City Election for Wards 1 and 3 were as follows:

Motion was made by Commissioner Don Boyd and seconded by Commissioner Bob Bowman that the results of the Regular City Election of May 6, 1989 have been canvassed and that Percy A. Simond be declared as Commissioner of Ward 1 and Danny Roper be declared as Commissioner of Ward 3. A unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.

3. OATHS OF OFFICE ADMINISTERED

Mayor Bronaugh administered the oath of office to Percy A. Simond as Commissioner of Ward 1 and Danny Roper as Commissioner of Ward 3.

4. BEAUTIFICATION AWARDS

Mayor Bronaugh recognized Stacy George, Executive Coordinator of Angelina Beautiful Clean. Ms. George stated that she was pleased

to present seven "Partners in Progress" awards to staff members in the City's Water Department.

Ms. George stated that over the past three years the staff has efficiently collected the voluntary 50 cent donations from citizens of Lufkin. Ms. George stated that ABC has collected over \$35,000 as of February 28th of this year. These donations have been used on educational material, anti-litter programming, a project at the Zoo, a recycling project and most recently planting flowers in four medians in the City.

Ms. George stated that initially the City Commission gave a \$5,000 donation to the ABC program and she would like to express her appreciation to the Commission for allowing the 50 cent donation to the water bill thus allowing ABC to receive the \$35,000, \$15,000 of which has been used in the operating budget.

Ms. George presented plaques to Drew Squyres, Utility Collection Manager, and Maxine Peters, Account Clerk in the Water Department. Ms. George presented five additional plaques to other Water Department employees following the meeting.

Mayor Bronaugh stated that he would also like to recognize Parks & Recreation Director Don Hannabas for putting the funds to good use in beautifying the City and to Finance Director Rita Jinkins.

5. COMMENTS

Mayor Bronaugh reminded members of the Commission that there would be a meeting of the Tax Abatement Committee at 10:00 a.m. in Room 202.

The Mayor and Commissioners expressed their disappointment in the low number of registered voters who turned out for the election.

Congratulations were extended to Commissioners Simond and Roper on their re-election to the Commission.
