MINUTES OF Regular MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD December 2nd, 1952, at 7:30 P. M.

On this the 2nd day of December, A. D., 1952, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in regular session in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof being present:

A quorum being present, the following business was transacted:

1 The Council on motion of Commissioner Stegall and seconded by Commissioner Zeagler, all voting "Aye", passed application for Zone changes of Church of Christ, O. C. Lowery, Jr. and W. A. Williford.

- 2. Mrs. Anice Chancy, appeared before the Council, asking that they approve her application for City Chauffeur's License. The Council agreed that Mrs. Chancey, meeting all requirements, should be issued City Chauffeur Licnese.
- 3 Ray Bazzoon of the North Side Taxi Company appeared before the Council asking that the City remove two parking meters in front of his Taxi Stand on Dozier Street, in order that he could widen and pave Drive In, entering on Dozier Street, Him to pay all expenses. The Council deferred the matter until they could obtain information as to cost of replacing meters and curb, should Mr. Bazzoon discontinue his business.
- The Council voted unanimously for a Christmas Bonus for all City Employees, to be determined as follows:

6 Months, and less than 1 year----10% 1 Year and over-----20%

5 The Mayor executed deed to Eli Bynum and Wife, Della Bynum, for a triangular strip of land abutting on the West side of Perry Drive and North Side of Highway 94, or Frank Street extension.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
