

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD AUGUST 7,
1956, AT 7:30 P..M.

On this the 7th day of August, A. D. 1956,
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened
in regular session, in the regular meeting place in

_____, constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.

2. The minutes of the regular meeting of July 17, 1956, and of the called meeting of August 1, 1956, were read and approved.

3. The following zone changes were granted: That of Bessie Renfro from "F" to "L" District on Lots Nos. 10, 11, and 12, in Block No. 1, of the East Lufkin Addition; that of Willie Renfro from "A" to "F" District on Lot No. 1 in Block No. 51 of the Denman Addition; that of Robert Denum from "A" to "K" District on Lot No. 2 in Block No. 3, of the Adams Addition; that that of S. H. Purvis from "A" to "K" District on a strip of land 15 feet by 50 feet on the North side of State Highway No. 94, out of the John Purvis 55 acre tract; that of H. E. Smith from "A" to "B" District on Lots Nos. 9, 10, and West 47 feet of Lot No. 8, in Block No. 47, W. C. Denman Addition.

4. A delegation of citizens from the vicinity of Paul Avenue appeared before the Commission and discussed the ~~hard~~ ^{city limits} surfacing of Paul Avenue from Timberland Drive to the ~~Brookshire Pond Road~~. The City agreed to furnish an estimate of the paving cost, and the committee was informed that if all property owners on each side would participate in the cost of such paving, it would be hard surfaced.

5. Bids were opened for the purchase of 100 parking meters. The bid of the Karpark Corporation being the lowest and best bid, the contract was awarded to this concern.

6. The City ordered publication of hearing on the zone application of Mrs. Nona Carson and Jack Nerren for zone change on property owned by each of them. Final hearing on these two zone changes were set for September 4, 1956.

7. A committee from the Rainbow Addition came before the Commission and requested sewer extension for this Addition. They were told that the extension of sewer service for this Addition was contemplated in the present program.

8. Dee Fields and Jack Lewis appeared before the Commission and requested the extension of a water line to the Sun Rise Addition. They were told that the City would look into the matter and they would be advised of the feasibility and cost of a water line to this particular Addition.

9. Mr. Dotson presented a plat of the David McD. Shearer Addition. Such plat was approved by the City Commission with the understanding that all requirements of the City Ordinance regulating the laying out of a sub-division would be complied with.

10. The ~~Committee~~^{Commission} authorized transfer of \$691.46, from the right-of-way funds to the general funds.

11. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
