MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD MARCH  
4th, 1924.

Be it remembered that on this the 4th day of March, A. D. 1924; there came on and was held a regular Meeting of the Honorable City Commission of the City of Lufkin, in the City Hall of said City, there being present and presiding the following officers:- Sam H. Kerr, Mayor, T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, C. F. Becker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, J. W. Lewis, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, *W. A. Behannon* (W.A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 being absent), W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and by move and second duly made and carried were approved as read.

A petition signed by W. T. Rodgers et als praying that that portion of the brick fire limits embracing the south half of Block No. twenty-one (21) in the City of Lufkin, Texas, being taking out of the said brick or fire limits. After reading said petition and considering the same, C. F. Becker, made a motion to table the petition, which said motion was seconded by W. B. Treadwell. The mayor put the question and all members of the City Commission present voted in favor of said motion, and the Mayor declared the motion carried.

The City secretary was instructed to get up data and information for purpose of presenting to Attorney General's Department at Austin, Texas, to ascertain what amount of bond issue would be approved for sewer and water works extension purposes.
