Sept. 17th, 1935.

The purpose of the meeting was to meet and discuss with Mrs C.W. Austin, the fiscal agent of the City in its refunding program, the plan he has worked out for such refunding. The matter was carefully considered and the plan discussed, after which by order of the City commission such plan was approved. On motion made by W. O. Greene, seconded by Louis Hicks it was unanimously carried that the Mayor issue a proclamation designating Sept. 19, 1935, as "Big Thursday". The Mayor was so authorized.
