2. The next matter for discussion was the employment of the city manager, and after full discussion of the applicants, and upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by B. F. Milligan, Mr. J. Thomas Kelley of Austin was employed as city manager at a salary of \$300 per month, effective as soon as Mr. Kelley can assume his duties.
