

CALL MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,  
TEXAS, HELD MAY 20th, 1920.

This day a special meeting of the City Commission~~er~~ was held at the Municipal Office of the City of Lufkin, Texas, with Mayor G. A. Kelley, Presiding, and Commissioners S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler and W. B. Treadwell, being present, City Manager L. Mitchell and City Secretary, T. L. Dunn, also being present.

The mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting, which said meeting should have been held on the 19th day of May, 1920, was to approve, pass upon and ratify, the City Budget of said City for the year beginning April 1st, 1920 and ending March 31st, 1921, which said Budget had heretofore been prepared by the City Manager and notice by publication having been made as required by law of this meeting, said meeting not be-  
held on the 19th as aforesaid for the reason that a quorum of the City Commission was not present, and said meeting was postponed until this date.

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After consideration of said budget as prepared by City Manager, L. Mitchell, W. B. Treadwell Commissioner of Ward No. 4 made a motion to adopt said Budget, and Commissioner B. L. Zeagler seconded said motion, and the mayor put the question and requested those members of said City Commission who favored the adoption of said Budget to vote "Aye, and those members of the City Commission who opposed the adoption of said Budget to Vote "No". The following members of said Commission voted "Aye"- S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler and W. B. Treadwell. The following members voted "No"- None. The mayor then declared the motion carried and the said Budget adopted, which said budget is as follows:-
