31st, 1932.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Purpose of the meeting to open bids for the annual audit of the City books and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

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Bids on the Annual audit were received and opened from the following:-

Nolan C. Phillips Co. Waco, Texas-	\$175.00 flat.
East Texas Audit Co Lufkin, Texas	225.00 flat.

On motion made by W.A. Abney seconded by M.M. Jones, that the contract be awarded to Nolan C. Phillips on their low bid of \$175.00 same carried unanimously.

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It being the beginning of a new fiscal year for the City of Lufkin, and the selection of new officers being in order, it was moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by M. M. Jones, that L. S. Atkins be appointed to the position of City Judge or Recorder. It was also moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by M. M. Jones that Dr. D.M. Childers be appointed to the position of City Health Officer. Both motions carried unanimously.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
