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MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JUNE 2nd,
1936.

Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of June, A.D. 1936 there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the city present and presiding, to-wit:-

Kenneth Hoskins, Mayor
W. O. Greene, Coms. Ward No. 1,
Lewis Hicks, Coms. Ward No. 2,
Curtis W. Fenley, City Attorney, and
T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and
Acting City Manager.

D. A. Campbell, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and J. E. Jay, Commissioner of Ward No. 4 were absent on account of being sick.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of meetings held during the month of May were read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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J. M. Singleton, owner of land over which the roadway to the City Water Plant passes made it known to the City Commission that if the City expected to continue to use said land for a roadway he would have to paid the sum of \$5.00 per month. The City Commission realizing that it would be necessary to have a road to the City water plant and that at this time no other way can be easily obtained without considerable expense, it was moved by Lewis Hicks and seconded by W. O. Greene that the said J. M. Singleton be paid the sum of \$5.00 per month, beginning with the Month of June, and to continue such monthly payments until such time as other arrangements can be made for a permanent road. The motion carried unanimously, and the City Secretary was instructed to make check for the above amount monthly until further orders.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE TAXES TO BE LEVIED, ASSESSED AND COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 1936, AND FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED AND ORDAINED"

was introduced for passage and approval on first reading.

W. O. Greene, made a motion that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it pass first reading. The motion was seconded by Lewis Hicks. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks. "NOES"- None.- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

278 An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS; FOR THE YEAR A.D. 1936"

was introduced for passage and approval on first reading. W. O. Greene, made a motion that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it pass first reading. Lewis Hicks seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks. "NOES"- None-. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

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An ordinance to be entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF CERTAIN KINDS OF MERCHANDISE ON SUNDAY AFTER NINE O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING" was considered for passage on first reading.

It was moved by Lewis Hicks that such ordinance be passed and approved on first reading. The motion was seconded by W. O. Greene. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, Mayor, W. O. Greene and Lewis Hicks, Commissioners. "NOES"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
