being present, with J. A. Abney and D. M. Thrash being absent, thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

This meeting was called for the purpose of public hearing on the following Zone change applications: B. W. Albritton change portion of F to J; F. W. Thomas, Portion E to F; W. C. Weaver portion of F to J; Winnie Henry Perry portion of B to F;. There were no citizens present to protest these changes and upon motion of E. A. Gibbs and seconded by B. F. Milligan, the changes were approved by unanimous vote.

It was moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by E. A. Gibbs that an ordinance be passed prohibiting a turn on street intersections where traffic lights are located, when the light is red. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

The type of road to be built in the new City Park was discussed and upon motion of B. F. Milligan and seconded by E. A. Gibbs, it was decided to use the natural base, with oil treatment type by unanimous vote of yeas.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
